2018 Pink Quilt Competition

Pink isn't just a colour, it's an attitude

PINK is a quilt exhibition from Oatley Cottage & Oatley Lions Club. It will be held at Oatley Uniting Church in conjunction with Oatley Lions Festival on Saturday 20th October 2018.

Pink, a delicate colour that means sweet, nice, playful, cute, romantic, charming, feminine, and tenderness. **Pink** is associated with bubble gum, flowers, babies, little girls, cotton candy, love and sweetness. **Pink** is also synonymous with the McGrath Foundation to raise money to place specialist McGrath Breast Care Nurses wherever they're needed, and make breast health understanding a priority.

Pink will be judged with awards allocated. Best of show will win a PFAFF sewing machine package valued at \$1000 from Blessington Pty Ltd. Other prizes are from major suppliers of fabric and sewing supplies including PK Fabrics, J Leutenegger, Sydney Sewing Supplies and XLN Fabrics.

To be eligible for a prize, quilts can be traditional, non-traditional, patchwork, applique &/or embroidery layered stitched textile with at least 3 distinct layers.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Exhibition is open to all quilters residing in NSW.
2. Entry must have been completed since January 2017.
3. Entry may have been exhibited at a prior exhibition.
4. Quilts will be judged on their interpretation and use of the colour PINK as well as originality, design, technique and craftsmanship. Quilts may be pictorial, geometric, abstract, machine or hand pieced and quilted.
5. Your quilt must be predominantly PINK i.e. at least 70% of the quilt top must be in any tone(s) of the colour PINK.
6. Width of quilt must be 120cm. Height of quilt must be 200cm.
7. Entrants may submit up to 2 quilts.
8. Each entry must have its own entry form.
9. Entry form to be posted/delivered to OATLEY COTTAGE 11 Frederick St Oatley NSW 2223 to arrive no later than 5pm, Friday 14th September 2018
10. Upon receipt of your entry form a digital label will be supplied. All quilts must have this label firmly attached to the back, detailing name and address of quilter and the quilt title.
11. A hanging sleeve with a finished depth of 10cm must be attached to the back of each quilt.
12. Quilts must be received by TUESDAY 16th October 2018 ready to exhibit.
